E hiahiatia ana:

- Te hīti mahi ‘Mahere Honohono’
- Te pūrākau *Whata rāua ko Tangowhiti*
- Te Arawhata Ārepa (hei rauemi tautoko)

Ngā Tohutohu:

- Ka pānui te ākonga i ngā kupu kei te mahere honohono.
- Ka āta whakaaro te ākonga ki ngā hononga o tētahi kupu ki tētahi atu, kātahi ia ka tā i tētahi raina hei hono i ngā kupu. Tērā pea e rua, e toru rānei ngā hononga ki te kupu kotahi.
- Kia mutu te hono haere ka tuhi he paku whakamāramatanga i te take i tūhono pēnātia ai ana kupu. Hei tauira ‘I hono au i a Whata ki a Ruruwhango i te mea ko Ruruwhango te ruru a Whata.’
- Hei mahi whakamutunga ka noho takirua, kia kōrerohia ngā rerenga e tūhonohono ai ngā kupu.


